You may be wondering what’s next for us. Well, our lease is up at the end of May, then we’re hauling our life to Texas. A CRU staff couple has graciously agreed to let us house and dog sit for them while they are on summer project for all of June and July. We will settle into our own apartment after that and get ready for the baby who will arrive in mid September. The next several months will be a wild ride for us, and we will need a lot of prayer. Leaving staff with CCC won’t be an easy transition. We’re leaving behind so many deep friendships, a terrific church family and many relationships with students. It’s hard to imagine. At the same time, we trust that God has new and beautiful things in store for us. He has already revealed bits of the path He has prepared.

If you have questions about support to our ministry as we transition off, here is some info. If you would be willing to continue giving through July, CCC allows for us to take severance pay. This is a huge help to us with all the costs associated with moving and preparing for the baby. After July, we will be in touch with several of you about supporting individuals in Utah with Cru.
