Small Group Questions for the week of: February 14th, 2010

Romans 5:3-4

1. How is it possible to “exult in our tribulations”? (5:3) How is the Gospel related to exulting in tribulations?
2. What is the logical progression that should spring from tribulations in the believer’s life? (5:4) What can disrupt this progression? How well do you deal with life’s tribulations?
3. How should “hope” be a central aspect of the Christian’s life? How does the “hope of the glory of God” connect with the hope here at the end of Romans 5:4?

Romans 5:5

4. How does “hope not disappoint”? (5:5) what kind of hope is Paul talking about here?
5. How is the love of God poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit? Is this God’s love for us, or our love for God? Why?
6. When was the Holy Spirit “given to us”? To what degree are you experiencing the Holy Spirit’s pouring out the love of God within your heart? How can you grow in this area?

What would God have you apply from these Scriptures?
